GT3 Lavaredo UCI Gravel World Series lights up the international gravel scene

Auronzo di Cadore, 19 June 2026

Everything is ready for the GT3 Lavaredo – UCI Gravel World Series, scheduled for tomorrow morning with the start set at **8:30 a.m.** along the shores of **Lake Santa Caterina**. The event confirms strong international participation, with **28 nations represented** and foreign athletes making up **20%** of the **650 registered participants**.

The **Medium course**, reserved for **women** and **men Over 60**, covers **105 km** with **2460 m of elevation gain**, while the **Long course**, open to all other categories, extends over **133 km** with **3170 m of elevation gain**. Both routes cross some of the most iconic areas surrounding the Tre Cime di Lavaredo, alternating fast sections, technical climbs and the typical alpine gravel terrain.

As per the UCI Gravel World Series regulations, the **top 25% of each category** will qualify for the **European** and **World Gravel Championships**.

Registrations remain open until tomorrow morning at the race office inside **Pala Tre Cime**. In the last few hours, a steady flow of athletes has continued to sign up, confirming the strong interest in one of the most anticipated events on the international gravel calendar.

It is difficult to make any predictions: the course rewards both **MTB** and **gravel bikes**, and the start list includes athletes with very different backgrounds — from road racing to gravel, all the way to **cross-country** and **marathon MTB**.
